



RICHMOND, VA (September 25, 2007) – Cavalier Telephone and TV, a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC), announced today that it has been awarded its first contract with the United States Air Force, allowing it to provide telecommunications services to Dover Air Force Base, Delaware.

Contracting officers from Tinker Air Force Base, Oklahoma, the procurement authority for the communications contract, formalized the agreement at a Post Award Conference in Dover this morning.
